JOURNEY TO RESURRECTION: CHANGED

A song that was a product of the contemporary gospel movement of the seventies that remains a favorite of our congregation today is the Tremaine Hawkins recording "Changed." The song describes some of the results of Christ's mighty saving work in the life of a believing sinner. This marvelous work of God has been variously labeled. Some call it "getting saved." Others have dubbed it being "converted," "coming to the Lord," accepting Christ the Lord." "Born again" remains the familiar description of this mighty work of God.

This season, I will reacquaint us with the truth contained in the "born again" passage of John chapter 3. We will explore passages that support John's primary purpose for writing—to demonstrate through the words and work of Jesus that He is the Christ resurrected to change any and all who would come to Him by faith.

As we enter this Resurrection (Easter) season, we will preach on Sunday and study on Wednesday from the Book of John. Let's ask the Lord for exceptional insight and grace so that we may see, believe, receive, and share the mighty claims of Christ. And because we do, may the Lord add to the number who will be able to echo the final line of that song— "What a wonderful change has come over me!"


